Two of the seven elective units may be selected from a Diploma qualification in another endorsed Training Package or within CPC08 Construction, Plumbing and Services Integrated Framework Training Package, ensuring the industry context of the qualification is maintained. Three of the seven elective units may be selected from either Certificate IV or Advanced Diploma in CPC08.
