Securing Jobs for Your Future - Skills for Victoria

Course Overview

The Certificate III in Children's Services is the entry level qualification for those wishing to obtain employment within the Children's Services industry. This course will provide participants with the skills and knowledge needed for employment as a Trained Childcare Assistant/Childcare Worker within a childcare facility.

Participants of this course will be provided with the necessary skills in order to efficiently:

- Work within the relevant legal and ethical framework
- Provide care for babies and children
- Identify and respond to children and young people at risk
- Ensure the health and safety of children, contributing to OH&S processes
- Participate and work effectively in the workplace with staff and families to care for children.

Who should enroll?

- Australian citizens or permanent residents
- Those wishing to become child care professionals and develop their careers
- Those who enjoy working with children and have a passion for the quality of child care.



Vocational Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this qualification you will be classified within the industry as a "Trained Child Care Worker". This program provides you with the opportunity to seek employment as a Childcare Worker, Childcare Assistant, Family Day Care Worker, Nanny, Outside School Hours Care Assistant, Recreation Worker, Playgroup Supervisor and Preschool/Kindergarten Assistant within the Children's Services industry.

Pathway

Upon successful completion of the Certificate III in Children's Services participants will have the option of further study as a pathway to the Diploma of Children's Services (Early childhood education and care) CHC50908.

Practical Placement and Assessments

It is a requirement of this course that participants undertake practical placement within a childcare centre for the duration of the course. Participants are to arrange this placement themselves which may be either paid or on a voluntary basis. Participants will need to complete a minimum of 13 hours practical placement each week and complete written assessment tasks per unit in order to graduate.
